
Court Issues Notice to Rhea Chakraborty in Case Filed by Sushant Singh Rajput's Sisters

Mumbai (News Desk): A Mumbai court has issued a notice to actress Rhea Chakraborty in a case filed by the late actor Sushant Singh Rajput's sisters. According to Indian media reports, the notice pertains to the final report submitted by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) regarding Sushant's death case. Rhea has been summoned to



appear on August 12. The CBI had submitted its final report in March 2025. Reports state that issuing a notice is part of the legal process, giving complainants an opportunity to contest the investigators' decision to close the case. Sushant's sisters, Priyanka Singh and Meetu Singh, raised objections against Rhea and also named Dr. Tarun Nathuram, alleging he prescribed medication to Sushant without proper medical supervision. The court will further assess the matter after Rhea Chakraborty submits her response

Yashma Gill Reveals Komal Meer Receiving Marriage Proposals



Aamir Khan to Release 'Sitaare Zameen Par' on YouTube Movies on Demand

Mumbai (News Desk): Bollywood superstar Aamir Khan has announced that the premiere of his film Sitaare Zameen Par will be held on YouTube instead of any OTT platform. The film is a sequel to the 2007 hit Taare Zameen Par and was released in cinemas on June 20. However, Aamir has now confirmed that the movie will be available exclusively on YouTube Movies on Demand starting from August 1. The film will also be accessible in 38 countries including the USA, UK, Canada, Australia, Germany, and Singapore. Speaking about his decision to release the film on YouTube, Aamir Khan said that nearly 15 years ago, he realized that only about 2–3% of audiences watched blockbusters like 3 Idiots or Dangal in theaters. He added, "So



the next thought I had was, how do we reach the remaining 97–98%? I want to make this convenience accessible to every Indian citizen."It is worth mentioning that viewers have alleged that Sitaare Zameen Par is a remake of the 2023 Hollywood film Champions, which starred Woody Harrelson, as both films reportedly share a similar plotline and scenes.

30th Death Anniversary of Actress Nadira to Be Observed on August 6

His iconic song "Sawan Aaye Sawan Jaye" continues to be played on the radio during pleasant weather. Ikhlaq Ahmed passed away on August 4, 1999, after

battling blood cancer.

Isha Koppikar Reveals Shocking Behind-the-Scenes Incident from 1998 Film "Chandralekha"

In an interview with Indian media, she revealed that during the shooting of the 1998 film Chandralekha alongside South Indian superstar Nagarjuna, she voluntarily asked to be slapped multiple times in order to bring realism to a scene. Isha said she was highly dedicated and wanted the performance to feel authentic, so she told Nagarjuna to slap her for real. Initially reluctant, Nagarjuna complied gently, but due to repeated takes —nearly 14 to 15 slaps—visible marks appeared on her face by the end of the shoot. She explained that she was struggling to portray the right level of anger, and the camera wasn't

the desired expression, prompting the direct pruting k for multiple retakes. Nagarjuna later apologized, but Isha reassured him, saying it was her own request. Isha Koppikar is known for her roles in Krishna Cottage, Pinjar, Kya Kool Hain Hum, and Don. She was last seen in the 2024 Tamil science fiction film Ayalaan.

Controversial Tik Toker Rajab Butt's Close Friends' Private Videos Leaked, Stirring Social Media Outrage



Karachi (News Desk): Private and explicit videos of Pakistani TikToker Rajab Butt's close friends have been leaked, shocking social media users. Following previous controversies involving female TikTokers, this time male influencers Haider Shah, Maan Dogar, and Shehzi have found themselves at the center of scandal as their completely nude videos circulate on TikTok and other platforms. Meanwhile, Rajab Butt's rumored relationship with fellow TikToker Zara Malik has also come under the spotlight. Reports suggest that Rajab is living with Zara in Dubai, raising allegations that he is cheating on his pregnant wife, Iman. The pair has been seen together frequently, including at a Qawwali night, and even appear to wear matching outfits, further fueling speculation about their closeness.
