

## *Actress Komal Aziz Khan Reveals Reasons for Leaving Showbiz Industry*



Karachi (News Desk): Renowned actress Komal Aziz Khan, a talented Pakistani artist and successful entrepreneur with 1.6 million social media followers, has revealed the reasons behind her decision to quit the showbiz industry and focus on her clothing brand. Speaking openly in a recent podcast, she explained that the environment of showbiz was not suitable for an educated person, as work timings were irregular and, although payment delays were not an issue for her, the overall atmosphere created difficulties. Komal said she had heard claims that the industry was toxic and unsafe for women, which she did not find entirely true, but she wanted to see a safer and cleaner working environment, pointing out problems such as unhygienic washrooms and bitter politics in the field, which led her to pursue business instead. She added that showbiz is a highly commercialized world where few actors are genuine, while most are attracted only by glamour, describing it as a colorful world that appeals mainly to substance abusers—something she could not deal with. Komal further shared that she left the industry quietly without posting emotional messages on Instagram, and revealed that she had even received threats from industry seniors, who warned her that once someone enters showbiz, it becomes impossible to leave. However, she stressed that it has been four years since she walked away and she has no intention of returning.

## *NCCIA Expands Probe Against YouTuber Ducky Bhai in Gambling Apps Promotion Case*



Lahore (News Desk): The National Cyber Crime Investigation Agency (NCCIA) has expanded the scope of investigation against YouTuber Ducky Bhai in the case related to the promotion of gambling apps. According to NCCIA, Ducky Bhai identified other individuals involved in the promotion during interrogation, and action has been initiated to arrest those suspects as well. The agency revealed that Ducky Bhai received payments for promoting gambling apps through Dubai-based accounts, and further inquiries are underway regarding these bank transactions. Officials added that he will also be investigated about his involvement in the promotion of other gambling applications. Currently, Ducky Bhai remains in NCCIA custody on physical remand and is scheduled to be presented before the court again on September 1.
