You Tuber Azlan Shah Reveals 300+ Uninvited Guests Crashed His Wedding



Karachi (News Desk) - Pakistani YouTuber and social media influencer Azlan Shah known for gifting a donkey to his bride on their wedding day — has revealed that over 300 uninvited guests showed up at his wedding. In a recent TV morning show appearance with his wife, influencer Dr. Warisha Javed Khan, Azlan shared some memorable wedding stories. He explained that their wedding invitation card was leaked on social media, leading to a massive influx of strangers at the event. "We invited around 300-400 people, but because the card went viral, almost 600 to 650 people turned up,"he said. "The hall capacity was only for about 300–400, so people had to sit on the floor. By the end, I was struggling to breathe in the crowd — but thankfully, the food didn't run out." Azlan Shah is the son of late veteran actor Shabbir Rana. He married Dr. Warisha Javed Khan in 2022, and the couple has a daughter together.

In a heartfelt video posted on Instagram, Arij revealed that her life had been going smoothly and joyfully until a sudden diagnosis changed everything within hours. She shared images from her journey, explaining that she had avoided speaking about it earlier out of fear of blame. judgment, rumors, and Choriocarcinoma, as she described, is a rare cancer originating in the uterus tissue, often developing after a molar pregnancy. It can spread quickly to other parts of the body, making it extremely dangerous. Arij said she underwent major surgery and, during treatment, was uncertain whether she would survive. Fawad Khan's Delayed Film "Abir Galal" to Release on August 29 Under New Title

Mumbai (News Desk) – Indian media has claimed that Pakistani superstar Fawad Khan's long-delayed and controversial film Abir Galal will now release on August 29, 2025, under a slightly modified title Abeer Galal. The film was originally set for release on May 12, but its launch was postponed following the April terrorist attack on tourists in Pahalgam, Indian-administered Kashmir, which left several dead. The Indian —a charge Pakistan has repeatedly denied. In the aftermath, India imposed bans on Pakistani artists and YouTube channels. As Fawad Khan played the lead role, Abir Galal faced an indefinite suspension. However, according to a Times of India report, the movie will now premiere globally, excluding India, due to the ongoing backlash against Pakistani talent. Industry experts note that the release model will follow that of Sardaar Ji 3, a Punjabi film starring Diljit Dosanjh and Pakistani actress Hania Aamir, which was not released in India but achieved significant success internationally.
