

American Singer Victoria Canal Accuses Powerful Music Producer of Sexual Abuse



York (News Desk) Renowned -American singer Victoria Canal has accused a powerful music producer of sexually abusing her. In a post shared on Instagram, Victoria Canal revealed that a strong figure in the music industry exploited her eight years ago. The 27-year-old singer disclosed in her lengthy note that when she was only 19, she was sexually harassed, but she never shared the incident publicly. She wrote that the traumatic experience has affected her body, mind, and soul for the past eight years, but on her birthday, she chose freedom by speaking out. Born without the lower part of her right arm, Canal alleged that the man gradually isolated her, touched her inappropriately, and took her pictures over the course of a year. She further claimed that she was threatened that her career would be destroyed if she exposed the abuse. According to her, a year later, the man admitted that his plan was to manipulate her into such a situation. The singer added that the incident shattered her life, but therapy helped her regain some normalcy. However, she has not disclosed the name of the producer yet, fearing retaliatory action against her.

Pakistani Actress Nimra Khan Recalls 2015 Accident That Put Her in Coma

Karachi (News Desk) – Pakistani actress Nimra Khan has revealed the harrowing story of a tragic accident she suffered in 2015, saying that 10 years ago, due to the accident, she went into a coma. Nimra Khan shared pictures on Instagram showing her in a severely injured condition, some taken while she was undergoing treatment in the hospital and others showing her sitting in a wheelchair after the car crash. The actress wrote that exactly 10 years ago, she witnessed the darkest chapter of her life, an accident that forced her to fight for every single breath. She explained that the accident left her in a coma and made her dependent on others for survival. Nimra Khan added that those were the most painful moments of her life, but the day she recovered marked a new beginning, which she calls her "day of independence," as it gave her another chance to live, love, and rise again with strength. Her story of courage and resilience during that difficult time has been widely praised by social media users, who are appreciating her bravery and strength




Arjumand Rahim Criticizes Declining Quality of Modern Dramas




Lahore (News Desk) - Senior actress Arjumand Rahim has expressed disappointment over the declining standards of today's dramas, saying that in the past, dramas were meaningful and full of lessons, whereas now ratings and money are prioritized over quality. Speaking on a private TV program, Arjumand Rahim said that most of today's drama stories are repetitive and revolve around domestic issues. She highlighted that many shows portray the same formula: the hero and heroine living under one roof, developing a relationship, and such dramas receive high ratings. She criticized a recurring element in Pakistani dramas, where characters often overhear conversations secretly or accidentally, calling it an unhealthy and overused trope. According to her, this practice is both unrealistic and creatively weak, yet it has become a common way to move the storyline forward. Arjumand Rahim further said that dramas from the 1970s were of higher quality, carrying strong messages and lessons for viewers. She stressed that while money and ratings are important, producers and writers must also ensure they are not sending out the wrong messages, urging the industry to raise its voice for more meaningful storytelling.

Veteran Marathi Actress Jyoti Chandekar Passes Away at 68


Malaika Arora Expresses Desire for Second Marriage at 51
