
Punjabi Film "Enna Nu Rehna Sehna Nai Aunda" Creates Buzz in Cinemas with Message of Unity


Govinda and Wife Sunita Dismiss Divorce Rumors as Old and Baseless

Initially scheduled for release on August 29, the film was delayed due to tensions between India and Pakistan, leading to its suspension in India. However, it will now hit theaters worldwide except in India. In Pakistan, Abeer Gulal will still release on August 29, where fans eagerly await its premiere. The film's music, composed by Amit Trivedi, has already been released and is gaining popularity ahead of its launch.



Emily in Paris Assistant Director Diego Borilla Passes Away During Filming in Venice

Venice (News Desk) Diego Borilla, the 47-year-old assistant director of the Hollywood romantic comedydrama series Emily in Paris, tragically passed away on set after suffering a sudden heart attack. The incident occurred on Thursday, August 21, 2025, at the historic Hotel Danieli in Italy, where filming for the show's fifth season was underway. Despite immediate medical efforts, Borilla could not be revived, and his death was confirmed at around 7:30 p.m. The fifth season's shoot, which began in Venice on August 15 and was scheduled to conclude by August 25, has been temporarily halted following the tragedy. Reports indicate that production will resume after Borilla's funeral, with the new season slated for release on Netflix on December 18, 2025.






You Tuber Rajab Butt Reacts to Arrest of Fellow You Tuber Ducky Bhai
