

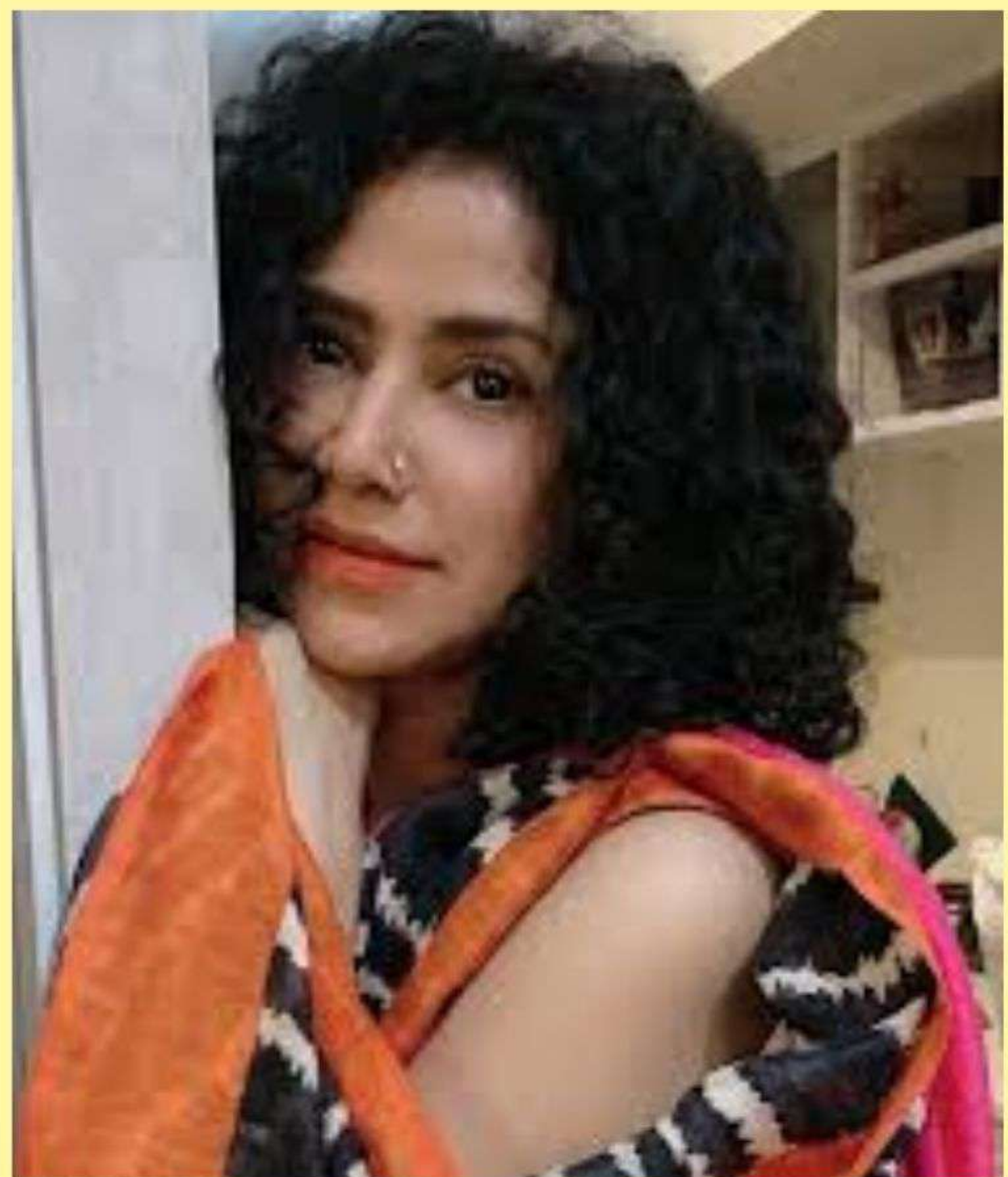
## *Areeba Habib Claims Awards Are Bought in Industry, Says “Bank Account Is the Real Award”*

## *Angeline Malik Reveals Battle with Ovarian Cancer, Says Treatment Still Ongoing*

Lahore (News Desk) Actress, model, producer, and director Angeline Malik has revealed that while she does not currently have active cancer, she is not yet fully cancer-free as her treatment is still ongoing. Speaking openly for the first time about her illness, Angeline disclosed that she was diagnosed with ovarian cancer, which had already reached stage three by the time it was detected. She first shared the news of her diagnosis in February 2025 but did not initially specify the type of cancer. Her treatment included surgery and chemotherapy, conducted in Pakistan, Dubai, and Turkey. In a TV program, she explained that she discovered her illness in December 2024 through a self-initiated CA-125 blood test, which came back positive, prompting further tests confirming stage three cancer. Angeline noted that she had no pain, fever, or visible symptoms, highlighting the silent nature of ovarian cancer. She further shared that her family has a history of cancer—her father, uncle, and two sisters had been diagnosed,



## *Parineeti Chopra and Raghav Chadha Expecting Their First Child*



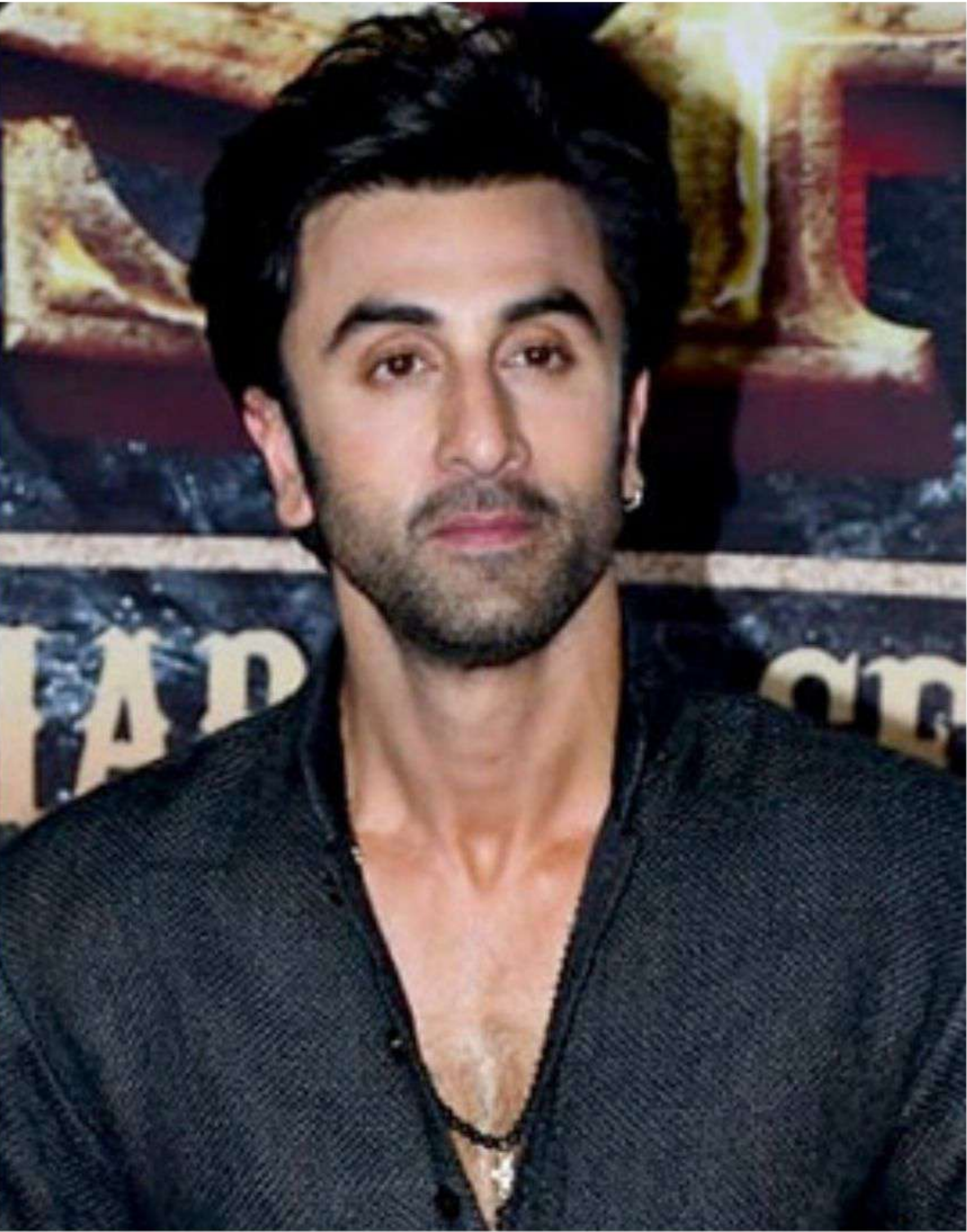
