

Hollywood Actress Kelly Wolf Arrested in Utah Over Social Media Dispute with Ex-Husband

New York (News Desk) – The Hollywood actress Kelly Wolf has been arrested following a social media dispute with her ex-husband Scott Wolf, which escalated to police involvement. According to American media, the former Real World reality star, 57, was taken into custody in Park City, Utah, on charges of harassment and sharing private information online. Prior to her arrest, Kelly Wolf posted on Instagram, sharing screenshots of her conversations with investigative authorities and expressing confusion about the police’s actions. In her post, she insisted that she was neither suicidal nor a threat to anyone, and claimed she had committed no crime. Shortly before being taken into custody, she reportedly shared Scott Wolf’s phone number on Instagram and made strong statements regarding their ongoing dispute. Kelly Wolf and Scott Wolf were married in 2004 and have three children together. In June of this year, Scott Wolf filed for divorce, and the court temporarily awarded custody of the children to him. Kelly has publicly alleged that she has been unable to see her children for several months, intensifying the ongoing conflict between the former couple.

South Indian Singer Sochtra Alleges Domestic Violence and Financial Fraud by Fiancé

Karachi Arts Council Announces 38-Day World Culture Festival 2025



Karachi (News Desk) – Karachi Arts Council of Pakistan has announced that the 38-day World Culture Festival 2025 will take place from October 30 to December 7. Council President Ahmed Shah, during a press conference, said that over 800 artists from 102 countries will participate in the festival, representing every region of the world. He explained that the festival was initially planned to be held four months earlier, but tensions between Pakistan and India, Independence Day events, and monsoon rains caused a delay. Last year, the festival ran for 38 days and hosted artists from 44 countries. This year, participants include 31 artists from Africa, 30 from Asia, 26 from Europe, and others from various countries. Shah added that 20 painters and sculptors will showcase their skills, while films, music, theater, and dance performances will also be featured. He described the previous year’s festival as the largest cultural event in Pakistan’s 78-year history, supported by the Sindh government, and emphasized that this year’s edition will be even more historic and inclusive, highlighting global talent and fostering cultural exchange.
