

# Pakistan Win T20I Series Against West Indies With 14-run Victory In Final Match



LAUDERHILL (News Desk): Pakistan secured a 2-1 series win over West Indies after defeating the hosts by 14 runs in the third and final T20 International played at Central Broward Park on Monday. After winning the toss, Pakistan captain Agha Salman opted to bat first, and the decision paid off as the visitors posted a competitive total of 189 runs for the loss of four wickets in their allotted 20 overs. Openers Sahibzada Farhan and Saim Ayub led the charge with impressive half-centuries, scoring 74 and 66 runs respectively. Hasan Nawaz contributed 15 runs, while Mohammad Haris was dismissed for just 2. In the closing overs, Khushdil Shah and Faheem Ashraf remained unbeaten on 11 and 10 runs respectively. For West Indies, Jason Holder, Roston Chase, and Shamar Joseph claimed one wicket each. In reply, the West Indies batting lineup fell short despite a steady start, managing 176 runs for six wickets in 20 overs—falling 14 runs short of the target. Pakistan made two changes to their playing XI, with Haris Rauf replacing Shaheen Shah Afridi and Khushdil Shah coming in for Fakhar Zaman. With this victory, Pakistan wrapped up the three-match series, having won the opening match while West Indies had bounced back to take the second and set the stage for a thrilling finale in Florida.

### General Women's Union Continues 'Suqia, Fatima Bint Mubarak' Initiative




ABU DHABI (News Desk): The General Women's Union (GWU), under the directives of H.H. #### Australia Develops World-first Foot And Mouth Vaccine To Protect Livestock

CANBERRA (News Desk): A team of scientists in New South Wales has developed the world's first mRNA vaccine designed to protect livestock from foot-and-mouth disease (FMD), a highly contagious viral illness that poses a major threat to livestock. This FMD vaccine is unique in that it is fully synthetic, making it safer and much faster to produce. The development of this new vaccine is part of the Minns Government's \$1 billion biosecurity plan, aimed at safeguarding New South Wales' US\$8 billion livestock sector and reinforcing national food security. The vaccine has taken less than 18 months to develop and has cost about \$2.5 million.



### Türkiye's Inflation Falls To 33.52% In July 2025



ISTANBUL (News Desk): Turkey's annual consumer price inflation dropped more than anticipated to 33.52% in July, according to data released on Monday by the Turkish Statistical Institute. The month-on-month inflation stood at 2.06%, lower than forecasted. In June, the monthly CPI increase was 1.37%, with an annual rate of 35.05%. Additionally, the domestic producer price index rose by 1.73% month-onmonth in July, resulting in an annual increase of 24.19%.

### KSE-100 Index Touches Recordbreaking 142,174 Points On First Day Of Business Week

KARACHI (News Desk): The Pakistan Stock Exchange (PSX) witnessed a remarkable surge on Monday as bullish sentiment among investors drove the benchmark KSE-100 Index to a new all-time high, signaling renewed confidence in the country's economic outlook. The trading week opened on a strong note, with the KSE-100 Index soaring by 1,139 points within minutes of the market opening. The index peaked at a record-breaking 142,174 points, surpassing last week's closing



level of 141,034 points. Market experts attributed the rally to a combination of factors, including improving economic indicators, investor optimism, and positive signals from policymakers. The continued momentum builds on last week's strong close and reflects a broader trend of growing stability and confidence in Pakistan's financial markets. "The consistency in policy direction and signs of macroeconomic recovery are playing a major role in this positive shift," said a senior market analyst. "Investor trust appears to be returning, and the market is responding accordingly." The ongoing rally has not only boosted investor morale but also raised hopes for further economic stabilization.

#### China's Major Internet Firms Log \$133.3 Billion In Revenues In H1

BEIJING (News Desk): China's internet sector recorded steady business growth in the first half of 2025, according to data released by the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology. From January to June, major internet and related services companies generated 961.3 billion yuan (approximately US\$133.3 billion) in business revenue, marking a 3.1 percent year-on-year increase

—2.2 percentage points higher than growth in the first five months. However, cumulative profits declined by 8.3 percent year-on-year to 74.32 billion yuan. Meanwhile, research and development spending in the sector reached 48.56 billion yuan, a 2.6 percent year-on-year rise. The report covers companies with annual business revenues of at least 20 million yuan.
