Embassy of Pakistan in Beijing Observes Youm-e-Istehsal Kashmir

Beijing (News Desk) — The Embassy of Pakistan in Beijing, today, observed Youm-e-Istehsal Kashmir (Day of Exploitation) in a solemn and dignified ceremony underscoring Pakistan's unwavering commitment to the Kashmir cause centred on inalienable right to self-determination of the people of Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK). The event commenced with the reading of messages from the President of Pakistan, Prime Minister, and Deputy Prime Minister/Foreign Minister, highlighting Indian measures to alter the demographic and political landscape of IIOJK over the past six years. Complementing the visual narrative, a photo exhibition was held, capturing the ongoing sufferings endured by the Kashmiri people.

GCWUF Observes Youm-e-Istehsal in Solidarity with Kashmiris



Faisalabad, (News Desk) — Government College Women University Faisalabad observed Youm-e-Istehsal with a protest walk to condemn the abrogation of Article 370 and express solidarity with the people of Indian-Occupied Kashmir. DPM Dar Asks India To Revoke All Illegal Actions Taken Against IIOJK



ISLAMABAD (News Desk): Deputy Prime Minister Ishaq Dar has said India must revoke all illegal actions taken on August 5, 2019, end its oppressive measures in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir, and lift the media blackout in the region. He was addressing a rally taken out in connection with Youm-e-Istehsal from Foreign Office to D-Chowk in Islamabad on Tuesday. The Deputy Prime Minister said Pakistan will continue extending diplomatic, political, and moral support to the Kashmiri people until their inalienable right to self-determination is realized. He underscored that Kashmir is an internationally recognized dispute, and its future cannot be determined through internal legislation or court rulings. Ishaq Dar also expressed concern over media reports suggesting that Indian authorities are attempting to grant statehood to Jammu while retaining the Kashmir Valley as a Union Territory. He condemned such moves as unacceptable and provocative. The Deputy Prime Minister reiterated that Pakistan believes in peaceful coexistence, but its commitment to peace should not be mistaken for weakness. He affirmed Islamabad's desire for friendly relations with all neighboring countries and its preference for dialogue and diplomacy over confrontation. He, however, warned that Pakistan's armed forces and its people are fully capable of delivering a resolute response to any act of aggression, as Marka-e-Haq. demonstrated during Addressing the rally, Minister for Information and Broadcasting Attaullah Tarar said Kashmir is our jugular vein and we firmly stand with our Kashmiri brothers and sisters.
