Naeema Butt faces criticism for saying she doesn't want to work in an industry where actresses are found dead

Karachi (News Desk): Actress Naeema Butt, who gained popularity from last year's drama *Kabhi Main, Kabhi Tum*, is facing criticism over a recent video in which she states she doesn't want to work in an industry where actresses are found dead. Naeema recently shared a short video on her Instagram story, responding in a unique way to fan questions



and criticism. In the video, she performs a scene where people claim she isn't getting acting roles, which is why she makes random videos on social media. She mocked such comments and added that she refuses to work in an industry where actresses and models are being found dead. She also featured her pet dog in the video, saying that her dog is more loyal than the showbiz industry. While she did not mention any names, her remarks were believed to reference actress and model Humaira Asghar and senior actress Ayesha Khan, both of whom were found dead in July.

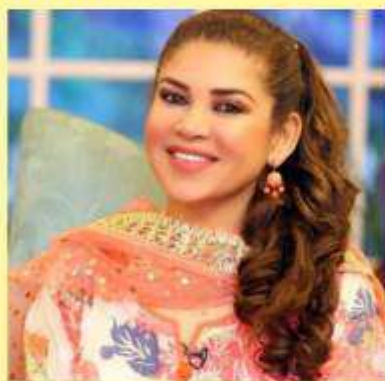
Michael Jackson's unwashed concert sock from 1997 sold for over €7,600 at auction



Los Angeles (News Desk): A sock worn by the late pop superstar Michael Jackson during a concert in France in the 1990s has been auctioned in its unwashed condition. Auctioneer Aureore Ély told AFP that Jackson had worn the white sock multiple times while performing his world-famous song "Billie Jean." After a concert in the southern city of Nîmes in July 1997, a technician reportedly left the used sock near Michael Jackson's dressing room. The sock was then carefully preserved for 28 years and recently put up for auction. Initially estimated to fetch between €3,000 and €4,000 (\$3,400–\$4,500), it sold for €7,688 (\$8,822) at a Nîmes auction house. This isn't the first time Jackson's clothing items, especially those worn during performances and music videos, have sold for large sums. In 2009, a gaming resort in Macau paid \$350,000 for the glittery glove Jackson wore during his first-ever "moonwalk" in 1983. Additionally, a hat worn just before that performance sold for over \$80,000 in 2023, and the leather jacket he wore in a 1984 soda commercial fetched more than \$300,000 the same year. Michael Jackson died in 2009 at the age of 50 due to a fatal overdose. Despite facing allegations of child abuse during his lifetime, his popularity remains undiminished to this day.

Mishi Khan advises girls not to share private videos and photos, even if marriage is promised

Karachi (News Desk): Actress Mishi Khan has advised girls not to send their private pictures or videos to anyone, even if a boy promises marriage. She said that even if the boy insists he is ready to marry and the wedding is about to happen soon, girls should still refrain from sharing such content. She emphasized that even married women should never send private material. Mishi Khan warned that one cannot predict when the other person might change their behavior and begin blackmailing, as many girls have fallen into such traps. She highlighted that some boys use threats to extort money, causing severe mental stress, and in some



cases, women have even committed suicide. She added that love and relationships are fine within limits, but many girls stop using their judgment while the boy is left smiling after getting what he wanted.

Actress Sharmeen Hina Rizvi confirms separation from husband Ammar Ahmed Khan

Karachi (News Desk): Renowned Pakistani actress Sharmeen Hina Rizvi has confirmed her separation from husband Ammar Ahmed Khan. In a message shared on social media, she stated that they are going through a separation phase, although no final decision regarding divorce has been made yet. On Instagram, she wrote that with a heavy heart, she is announcing that she and her husband are currently separated and both need time to think about the future of their relationship. She requested people to respect their privacy and refrain from making negative comments, noting that only those in a marriage truly understand the complexities of the relationship. She added that this was not an easy decision and humbly asked the public to avoid passing negative remarks on social media, as they are under emotional pressure while trying to make important life decisions. A few days earlier, she had also shared posts on her Instagram stories hinting at the separation. Through videos, she further expressed her frustration with those criticizing her personal life. It is worth mentioning that Sharmeen Hina Rizvi and Ammar Ahmed Khan were married in April 2024 in a beautiful, star-studded ceremony attended by showbiz celebrities and close family members.
