

Karishma Kapoor’s Children Approach Court for Share in Late Father Sanjay Kapoor’s Estate



Mumbai (News Desk) – Bollywood actress Karishma Kapoor’s children have petitioned the court to claim a share of the late billionaire Sanjay Kapoor’s estate. According to the Press Trust of India, the children filed an application in the Delhi High Court on September 9, seeking their inheritance from their father’s property, which was reportedly worth 30,000 crore Indian rupees. The petition challenges a will revealed on March 21, in which Sanjay Kapoor allegedly left his entire estate to his second wife, Priya Kapoor. Filed on behalf of daughter Samaira and son Kiaan, the petition claims that Sanjay never mentioned the will to them, nor did Priya or anyone else inform them about it. The petition alleges that Priya’s behavior following Sanjay Kapoor’s death indicates that the will is forged and was prepared under suspicious circumstances. It further states that the purported will is neither legal nor valid, and no original copy was presented while only a questionable version was shown to seize the property. The petition requests a permanent injunction on the division, accounting, and transfer of the estate and asks the court to direct Priya Kapoor to disclose full details of all property and personal belongings of Sanjay Kapoor. Samaira filed the case through her mother Karishma Kapoor, who holds a general power of attorney, while minor Kiaan is also represented by his mother as guardian. Karishma Kapoor and Sanjay Kapoor married in 2003 and divorced in 2016, after which Karishma had accused her former husband of domestic violence and serious allegations including sexual exploitation.

Over 1,300 International Artists Pledge to Boycott Israeli Film Industry Over Gaza Crisis

New York (News Desk) – More than 1,300 international artists, directors, and filmmakers, including those from Hollywood, have pledged to boycott Israeli film institutions amid ongoing violence and atrocities in Gaza. According to foreign media reports, the pledge was released by the “Film Workers for Palestine” group and has been signed by numerous prominent actors, directors, and filmmakers from Hollywood and Europe. An Al Jazeera report stated that the signatories include A-listers such as Olivia Colman, Ayo Adiberri, Mark Ruffalo, Riz Ahmed, Tilda Swinton, and Javier Bardem, who committed not to work with Israeli film institutions, festivals, broadcasters, or production companies involved in the genocide and racial oppression of the Palestinian people. The pledge emphasizes that they will neither screen films nor collaborate with any Israeli entity complicit in these atrocities.

Khalid Anam Urges Pakistanis to Strengthen Moral Values Amid Corruption Concerns

Karachi (News Desk) – Senior actor and singer Khalid Anam has stated that Pakistanis need to correct their moral system, noting that people place more faith in money than in Quaid-e-Azam, and where there is a large portrait of the nation’s founder, corruption is often rampant. Speaking on the FHM podcast, Khalid Anam discussed various issues, emphasizing that just as children are vaccinated to protect them from diseases, society must strengthen its moral “fiber system” to prevent ethical decay. He lamented that in Pakistan, no criminal has been severely punished to set an example, as people prioritize money over principles. Referring to a book by Quaid-e-Azam’s close friend Kauser J. Syed, Anam highlighted a statement suggesting that if Jinnah had known the nature of Pakistanis, he might never have created the country. He further noted that Pakistanis have not even treated Quaid-e-Azam properly, citing the example of ambulances being neglected, with many remaining non-functional across the country, affecting funeral services. Khalid Anam concluded that in Pakistan, money is respected more than law, and areas with large portraits of Quaid-e-Azam often witness the highest levels of bribery and corruption.



Emerging Actress Aiman Zaman Confirms Separation from Husband Mujtaba Lakhani Amid Allegations

Karachi (News Desk) – Emerging actress and social media star Aiman Zaman has announced her separation from husband Mujtaba Lakhani, a year and a half after their marriage, also alleging betrayal on his part. Recently, Aiman answered fans’ questions on social media, where several asked whether she had truly separated from her husband. She confirmed that the separation is true but stated that she does not wish to discuss the matter in detail. When asked if people change after marriage, Aiman explained that it depends on the individual and the nature of the partner; if someone starts hiding things or deceiving their partner, it is best to part ways. She elaborated that a person who truly loves never betrays, never lets their partner cry, does not allow tears in their eyes, fears losing love, and never deceives. She emphasized that a sincere person never stops respecting or loving, and anyone who betrays cannot be considered genuine. Aiman added that repeated betrayal or disrespect requires caution, and one should distance themselves from such individuals. While she did not provide specific details about the issues leading to the separation, she confirmed the split. Meanwhile, alleged screenshots of her husband, Mujtaba Lakhani, have circulated, claiming that Aiman has not yet sent him divorce papers, indicating that their marital relationship has not legally ended. Aiman Zaman and Mujtaba Lakhani had married in February 2024 after a period of courtship, and now, a year and a half later, news of their separation has emerged.
