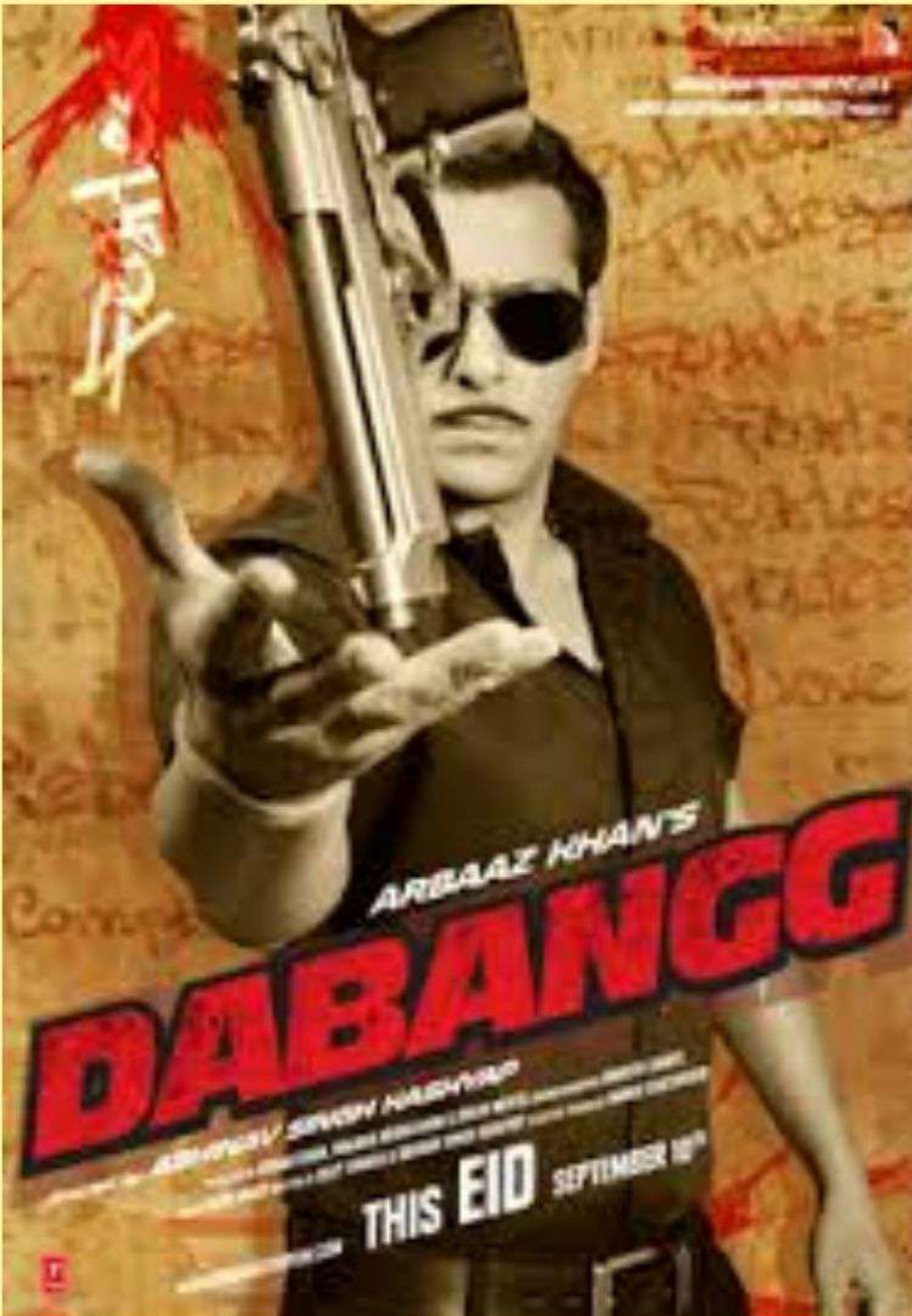


Mumbai (News Desk) Today marks 15 years since Bollywood superhit film Dabangg was released on September 10, the same day renowned actress Sonakshi Sinha began her film career. She won hearts with her dialogue, "Thappad se dar nahi lagta, sahil pyar se lagta hai," in her debut opposite Salman Khan, who played the lead role of Chulbul Pandey, while she portrayed Raju. Sonakshi's co-star Zaheer Iqbal revealed to Indian media NDTV that he has still not watched the blockbuster film Dabangg. During an interview, Sonakshi reacted to her husband's statement, saying, "Zaheer, you still haven't watched Dabangg? Shame on you." Zaheer responded that he will watch the film soon.



Mumbai (News Desk) Over the past two days, rumors circulated on social media claiming that popular South Indian and Bollywood actress Kajal Aggarwal had died in a road accident, causing concern among her fans. Responding to the false news, the actress appeared publicly yesterday and dismissed the rumors, assuring her fans that she is completely safe and healthy. In a social media post, Kajal said, "I saw some unverified news claiming that I was injured in an accident and no longer in this world. Honestly, it's quite strange. By God's grace, I am perfectly fine. I request everyone not to believe or spread such false news." According to Indian media, today the actress was seen visiting a salon in Mumbai, smiling for pictures and even taking a photo with a fan. She added that although she does not take such rumors seriously, her family was worried by these false reports and urged fans to focus on positivity and truth.



Los Angeles (News Desk) The decomposed body of a person was discovered in a car belonging to popular American rapper D Far V D, who is currently on a world tour promoting his new album. The body, wrapped in a plastic sheet, was found in the trunk of a seized Tesla that had been parked in Toward for several days. According to media reports, the car is registered under the rapper's name, and he has not yet commented on the incident. Los Angeles Police Department's Robert Peters told reporters that they received a tip this morning about a body inside a car that had been parked for several days. US media reports stated that the vehicle was found near Elon Musk's new Tesla design facility, which had a grand opening in July. The young rapper gained fame in 2022 after a viral song on TikTok.



Mumbai (News Desk) Mandira Kapoor Smith, sister of the late Sanjay Kapoor, reacted to Delhi High Court's directive for widow Priya Kapoor to declare assets, expressing support for Karisma Kapoor's children. Speaking to Indian media on Wednesday, she said she stands with the children, noting that it is encouraging that the family will now have some clarity. She added that the situation should become more transparent and visible. The drama revolves around the late businessman Sanjay Kapoor, who passed away at 53 during a polo match in the UK this June, leaving assets worth approximately 30,000 crore rupees. Karisma Kapoor's children, Samaira and Kiaan, Sanjay's biological offspring, filed a case in Delhi High Court alleging that their stepmother Priya Sachdeva Kapoor attempted to manipulate their father's will. Mandira expressed that she supports the children's actions, emphasizing that it is unreasonable and meaningless if someone aware of their father's relations fails to include them in the will.



Karachi (News Desk) Significant development has emerged in the investigation of model and actress Hamira Asghar's death after her final medico-legal report was prepared. The report has raised suspicions surrounding her death, revealing that her clothes were stained with blood. According to the report, blood and DNA traces were found on Hamira's T-shirt and trousers. Only her skeletal remains were recovered, and due to the absence of soft tissue, the exact cause of death could not be determined. Sources revealed that no database exists for blood or DNA comparison, and Hamira's mobile phone, which could have aided the investigation, has not been recovered. Hamira Asghar's body was discovered on July 8 in a flat in Defence Phase 6, Karachi. She had been living alone in the rented flat for seven years after moving from Lahore to Karachi in 2018. SSP South, Mahzur Ali, stated that the woman had not paid rent since 2024. The landlord had filed a case with Clifton Cantonment Board, and upon the bailiff's arrival, the door was locked. When the door was forcibly opened, Hamira's body was found on the floor.



Karachi (News Desk) Actress and TV host Ushna Shah revealed that she spent her childhood in Canada and received her education there, which is why her style of speaking English has a Canadian accent—a trait that has often drawn criticism. The actress recently participated in a podcast where she spoke openly on various matters. During the program, she also discussed local languages and expressed regret that Punjabis do not take pride in their mother tongue and rarely speak Punjabi. According to Ushna Shah, she has spent more time in Karachi than in Lahore, and many of her multilingual friends communicate in their native languages. She noted that particularly Sindhi and Pashto speakers converse in their mother tongues, and globally, speakers of Persian and other languages also communicate in their native languages. The actress expressed disappointment that Punjabis do not speak their mother tongue and questioned why they have issues with their own language. During the program, Ushna spoke in her native Punjabi and also conversed in Urdu and English. She reiterated that her childhood in Canada and education there contributed to her Canadian-accented English, which has repeatedly been criticized. Ushna Shah further revealed that her brother often teased her for speaking English with a Canadian accent, and others also mocked her. She explained that while Pakistanis criticize someone for speaking incorrect English, they simultaneously accuse those who speak good English of imitating foreign styles.

Karachi (News Desk) Actress and TV host Javeria Saud humorously criticized matchmaking aunties, saying that while the world has progressed, our aunts, grandmothers, and elder women are still stuck on issues of being dark-skinned or overweight. Responding to a video of a matchmaking woman, Javeria did not name anyone specifically but satirized the content. In the video, the woman discussed girls' body types and skin tones, claiming that overweight girls are shy and hesitant to appear in public, and dark-skinned girls also lack confidence. She added that slim and fair-skinned girls are confident, speak up, and do not face any issues. Commenting on the video, Javeria Saud wrote, "The world has progressed, but our elder women are still stuck on dark and overweight." She elaborated in her comment, stating that our elder sisters, aunts, grandmothers, and maternal relatives are still obsessed with these outdated standards.
