
Ayesha Omar to Host Unique Urdu Reality Dating Show "Lazawal Ishq"


Canadian-Based Gang Claims Responsibility for Firing Outside Disha Patani's House

Mumbai (News Desk) – The gang of Goldy Brar, a Canada-based gangster, has claimed responsibility for the firing incident outside Bollywood actress Disha Patani's house. According to police, the incident took place in Civil Lines, Bareilly, where multiple shots were fired outside the actress's residence. Fortunately, no casualties were reported.

The gang accepted responsibility through a social media post written in Hindi, claiming that the act was in response to the alleged disrespect of prominent religious figures by Disha Patani and her sister Khushboo Patani. The message stated that the firing was merely a "trailer" and warned that if anyone insulted their religion in the future, no one would be spared.


Authorities confirmed that investigations are ongoing and the authenticity of the social media claim is being verified. Khushboo Patani described the incident as extremely distressing. Reports suggest that the controversy originated from statements made by Khushboo Patani about religious leader Anirudh Acharya's views on women and livein relationships, which were later twisted and circulated on social media, falsely alleging that she insulted Premanand Maharaj.

Police have increased security around the actress's residence, stating that the family's safety is their top priority.




Two Men Fight in Cinema Over Spoilers During The Conjuring Screening

Pune (News Desk) – A Hollywood horror film screening of The Conjuring in Pune turned chaotic when two men got into a physical altercation over spoilers. According to Indian media reports, a 29-year-old software professional had gone to watch the movie with his wife, while another man arrived with his wife and sat in the row behind them. During the film, the man in the back row loudly narrated the story to his wife, disturbing nearby viewers. The 29-year-old professional objected and asked him to stop spoiling the suspense and not disturb others, which escalated into a confrontation. Police reported that when the couple tried to intervene, the man began assaulting them, prompting the complainant to contact authorities. The complainant sustained minor injuries, and a case has been registered against the accused under various sections.

Tik Toker Samia Hijab Forgives Ex-Fiancé, Withdraws All Cases

Islamabad (News Desk) – TikToker Samia Hijab has announced that she forgives her former fiancé, Hasan Zahid, who allegedly harassed, attempted to abduct, and physically assaulted her, and has decided to withdraw all cases filed against him. On September 1, Samia shared a video on Instagram claiming that Hasan Zahid had tried to abduct her, subjected her to physical abuse, and blackmailed her. Following her complaint, Islamabad police arrested Hasan Zahid and initiated legal proceedings. Initially, the court granted physical remand to the police, but on September 12, Hasan Zahid was sent to jail on a 14-day judicial remand. After his imprisonment, Samia confirmed that she had reconciled with her former fiancé and forgiven him in the name of God. She told multiple media outlets that Hasan Zahid's family came to apologize, prompting her decision to forgive him. According to her, Hasan Zahid also gave a written assurance not to take any further action against her. She firmly rejected claims that her forgiveness was financially motivated, stating that she forgave him purely for the sake of God. Samia clarified that her engagement with Hasan Zahid is over, she feels safe, and no longer considers him a threat.



Raj Kundra Denies \$72 Million Fraud Allegations



Mumbai (News Desk) – Bollywood actress Shilpa Shetty's husband and Indian businessman Raj Kundra has denied allegations of alleged fraud worth ₹6.04 billion (approximately \$72 million). Speaking to the media during the promotion of his Punjabi film Mehr in New Delhi, Kundra stated that he has done nothing wrong and that the truth will soon come out. He said, "We have not said anything so far because we know we are innocent; the truth will be revealed soon."

The allegations were made by 60-year-old businessman Deepak Kothari, who claimed that he was defrauded by Raj Kundra and Shilpa Shetty in an investment deal carried out between 2015 and 2023. According to Deepak, in 2015 he was persuaded to lend ₹7.5 billion to Best Deal TV Private Limited, co-owned by Kundra and Shetty, at an annual return of 12%. Over time, a total of ₹6.04 billion was transferred to Raj Kundra, but the agreement was later allegedly converted into an investment deal. Deepak further claimed that Shilpa Shetty had provided a personal guarantee for the deal in April 2016, but resigned from her position as company director in September 2016. He also alleged that bankruptcy cases were ongoing against the company at that time, which were allegedly concealed from
