

Islamabad Police Arrest Man for Harassing TikToker Samia Hijab



Islamabad (News Desk): Islamabad Police have arrested a man named Hasan Zahid for allegedly harassing TikTok star Samia Hijab, and for issuing threats of murder and abduction. According to a police spokesperson, the action followed Samia Hijab's complaint and video statement. A case has been registered at Shalimar Police Station under Sections 354 (assault or use of force with intent to dishonor a woman), 365 (abduction), 392 (punishment for robbery), 500 (defamation), 509 (harassment of women), and 511 (attempted offense) of the Pakistan Penal Code.

Details reveal that the suspect had been following Samia Hijab for several days, repeatedly pressuring her with gifts. Samia stated that Hasan Zahid proposed marriage, and upon her refusal, continued to harass her and even reached her home, threatening to kill her if she did not accept. In a video statement, she explained that the suspect rang her doorbell and, upon opening, forcibly tried to take her along while snatching her phone and sitting in the vehicle. When she attempted to retrieve her phone, he harassed her and tried to abduct her. Police say further investigation is ongoing, and substantial evidence is being collected against the suspect.

Besides film songs, he penned numerous folk songs, while the ghazal "Dil Ke Afsanay" from the film Baji also gained widespread acclaim. Ahmad Rahi passed away on September 2, 2002, in Lahore after a brief illness.

Mexican Tik Tok Influencer Esmeralda Ferrer Garibay and Family Found Murdered



Mexico City (News Desk): In a shocking incident, Mexican Tik Tok influencer Esmeralda Ferrer Garibay, her husband, and their two children were found murdered. The bodies, wrapped in plastic, were recovered from a vehicle in the San Andrés area of Guadalajara. Prosecutor Alfonso Gutiérrez Santillán confirmed the identities as 32-year-old Esmeralda, 36-year-old Roberto Carlos Gil Lesia, 13-year-old son Gil Santiago, and 7-year-old daughter Regina. Police briefly detained three employees from a nearby mechanic shop but released them due to lack of evidence; surprisingly, these individuals were abducted by armed unknown assailants minutes after leaving the prosecutor's office. Investigators found bloodstains, bullet casings, and other evidence at the nearby auto repair shop, suggesting the family may have been killed there before their bodies were moved. Preliminary reports indicate Roberto may have been the primary target.
